We Begin:

Have you noticed anything happening near the Town Hall on Calkins Road? Construction has begun on the new Town Recreation Center. Voters approved this project on November 3rd and site preparation began 48 hours later. This new 41,000 square foot facility evolved with significant input from the Recreation Staff, town residents and a conscientious Parks & Recreation Advisory Board.

Scheduled for completion early in 2017, this state-of-the-art center will include a gymnasium (featuring basketball, volleyball & pickleball courts), an indoor walking track, activity room, multipurpose meeting room, dedicated gymnastics area and a preschool activity room.


