



Open Swim

The Rush-Henrietta Senior High School pool is open to residents only for family open swim during the summer swim lesson season. Preregistration is required for anyone who will be swimming and can be done online or by submitting a registration form to the Recreation Department. **This program is free for residents only.** Please register for any session you plan to attend. For admittance to the pool, the following rules will apply:

- Participants who have completed 4th grade or younger must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 who remains in the pool area.
- Participants who have completed 5th through 7th grades must be signed in and out by an adult over 18 who remains in the pool area.
- Participants who have completed 8th grade and up must sign in and out.
- Adult participants must sign in and out.

Pool Rules

- Participants who have completed 4th grade or younger must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 who remains in the pool area.
- Participants who have completed 5th through 7th grades must be signed in and out by an adult over 18 who remains at the pool area.
- Participants who have completed 8th grade and up must sign in and out.
- Adult participants must sign in and out.
- Once admitted to the pool, all rules posted on the premises must be followed. Failure to do so will result in immediate removal from the pool and, if appropriate, the participant's emergency contact will be notified.
- Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult in the water. To be classified as a swimmer, one must be able to enter and exit the water without assistance; float on stomach and back without assistance; and proceed across the width of the pool, using any form, without assistance. At any time, a lifeguard has the right to remove any participant who is deemed to be in an unsafe circumstance.
- The school district, Town, and pool staff are not responsible for lost or stolen items. A lock may be used to secure personal belongings during open swim, but must be removed at the end of each open swim. Any locks not removed shall be subject to removal by school personnel who shall be authorized to damage or destroy the same if necessary.
- Anyone entering the Senior High School to participate in open swim, who is found to be in areas of the high school other than the pool, including school grounds, shall be deemed to be trespassing and shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.

Only Coast Guard approved flotation devices may be used in the pool; NOT acceptable are: swimmies, bathing suits with flotation pockets, bubbles, and any other non-regulation flotation device.
