

2017 Fourth of July Fireworks Specifications

- DATE:** Tuesday, July 4TH, 2017
- NO SHOW:** The Town shall determine if fireworks are to be cancelled due to inclement weather. In the event of weather cancellation, contractor must agree to retain all fireworks and materials at no cost to the Town. In the event of weather cancellation, the Town may, at its option, reschedule the show.
- FEE FOR SERVICE:** Not to exceed \$17,000.00.
- INSURANCE:** A Certificate of Insurance showing inclusion of the following must be submitted with the proposal.
- 1) Each Occurrence Limit in the amount of \$1,000,000.00
 - 2) Policy General Aggregate Limit in the amount of \$2,000,000.00
 - 3) Personal and Advertising Injury in the amount of \$1,000,000.00
 - 4) Products / Completed Operations Aggregate Limit of the amount of \$1,000,000.00.
- DISPLAY:** Contractor shall furnish a 35-45 minute fireworks show, with a large variety of visual and audible sound effects, including music. Contractor's bid shall include a list shall detailing the number and diameter of all shells being used as well as the number of visual effects and reports for all phases of the show.
- PERSONNEL & EQUIPMENT:** To be furnished by contractor including transportation and workmen's compensation insurance.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Contractor must show proof of meeting the Fire Code of New York State Chapter 56, Sect. 5601.2.4 and Sect. 5608. Contractor must also show proof of licensure from New York Licensing Bureau of an Explosive / Fireworks License.
- Contractor shall show documentation of Fireworks displays for Municipalities for the last 5 years.
- SATISFACTION:** Contractor must agree that satisfaction is guaranteed. If determined by the Town Board of the Town of Henrietta that the service or quality of the contractor or display is not satisfactory, the contractor must agree to forfeit all pay and other considerations for services.
